Social Innovation – Programme Approach

Two main challenges for the FCE area...

- ✓ The need to support the development of innovative solutions to address the societal challenges faced by the most socially and economically disadvantaged groups.
- ✓ The need to enable the active population to play their part in economic revitalisation, including by enhancing skills through innovative training/retraining.



Social Innovation – Programme Approach

... leading to two target groups:

✓ Those furthest from the labour market

✓ The ageing population



Specific Objective 1.2 - Indicators

- Why do we have indicators?
 - Result and Output

 Result Indicator: Level of quality and effectiveness of the service provided to disadvantaged groups



Specific Objective 1.2 - Indicators

Output Indicators:

✓ Number of participants in projects promoting gender equality, equal opportunities and social inclusion across borders.

✓ Number of skills development and professional training schemes for disadvantaged people.



Specific Objective 1.2 - Indicators

Output Indicators:

- ✓ Number of institutions, public or private, engaged in delivering social innovation solutions to increase the quality and effectiveness of service delivery to the most socially and economically disadvantaged groups.
- ✓ Number of socially innovative services designed

What is the key to delivering a good Interreg project?

- Be innovative
- Have a clear logic
- Cross border cooperation
- Creating strong partnerships
- Do your research
- Contact your facilitator



How to demonstrate a clear logic behind the project idea?

 What are our common needs and/or potential?

Project idea

Project objectives and results

- What do we want to change?
- How will it be different from the current offer/practice?

 What do we need to do to deliver this change?

Project outputs and indicators

Work plan and budget

- How will we do it?
- What resources do we need to carry out this work?



Regular project v. Micro-project

- 69% ERDF
- No ceiling for the budget
- No maximum length of project
- At least one partner from each country within the Programme area (no maximum)
- All legal entities are eligible
- Two phase application process

- 80% ERDF
- 500,000 euros max. budget
- 27 months max. length of project
- At least one partner from each country within the Programme area Maximum of 5 partners
- Open organisations employing less than 50 people and whose annual turnover does not exceed 10 million euros and all Local Authorities
- One phase application process
