





## Programme update

Happy Easter to all of our projects from the Interreg FCE Programme team. We thank you for your continued hard work and hope you enjoy the long weekend. In the March edition we're pleased to share many positive updates from the past few months.

#### Commitment target

We're pleased to announce that the FCE programme has reached its commitment target, with €217.5m pledged to projects delivering economic, social and environmental benefits for the Channel area.

## New projects approved

We approved five new projects, including two micro projects, at the Selection Sub Committee (SSC) virtual meeting on the <u>28 January 2021</u> and a further two projects at the SSC on the <u>23 March 2021</u>. In total, we now have 51 projects as part of the Interreg FCE family. More information to follow on our website soon.

#### Call for Capitalisation

The deadline for applications to our 'call for capitalisation projects related to Covid-19 recovery' has been extended until 30 April 2021. We have €4.1m ERDF left in our funding pot and the maximum ERDF grant rate for partners is 100% of the total capitalisation project budget, unless the project/partners are State Aid relevant. The Regiostars Awards are an annual competition, organised by the European Commission, aimed at identifying best practice in regional development and inspiring others by sharing the impact of EU funded projects.

## Launch of FCE Communications Network
